

1) *Complete the *application form

All students must first complete an application form and *submit the form, *along with a \$30 application fee, to: Southfield Community College Enrollment Services, Main Hall, 4013 College Avenue, Spring View, MA 01108.

2) Take the *placement test

After your completed application form is received, you will be sent an acceptance letter. To schedule a time for the placement test, please call 843-555-1710. You will take the test on campus in the computer *lab. The computer will *generate your test score and will send you the titles of *appropriate courses. The next step is to take your printed test score to an academic advisor.

3) Meet with an academic advisor

Before you can *register for courses, you must meet with an academic advisor to discuss your score. After discussing your schedule and advising you on the appropriate courses, the advisor will give you a registration form. The advisor must sign the form. Advisors are available Monday through Friday from 8 A.M. -5 P.M.

4) Register for courses

After meeting with an academic advisor, you can register for courses. Complete the registration form, including the section numbers, class titles, and meeting times. Submit your registration form *in person or by mail to Enrollment Services with full *payment by *check or credit card. If you have any questions, please call Enrollment Services at 843-555-1710.

People in many parts of the world are hungry every day, but in some places, a lot of food is <u>othrow</u> away. Food is wasted when farmers cannot sell their crops, or when restaurants and supermarkets make or buy more food than they need — but most food waste <u>ohappen</u> at home, and the problem is biggest in rich countries.

Every year, people and businesses in the USA waste about 60 billion kilograms of food — 33% of all the food in the country. Companies use a lot of energy when they make food and move it from place to place to sell — so when food is not used, energy is wasted and pollution is produced, *for nothing. Food *decomposes — it breaks into smaller and smaller pieces, and goes back into the land. But when it decomposes, it produces strong gases that 3 be very bad for the environment.

A lot of our food comes from very far away. People in Italy can buy coffee from Brazil and fish from Spain — and in shops in Japan, there is meat from the USA and vegetables from China.

But some people think that when food is moved across the world, this wastes (ち) and causes (い).

Even when people eat food that was grown in their country, it has probably travelled far. Until recent times, *sugar cane, the plant that produces sugar, grew on the island of Maui, in Hawaii — but the sugar from Maui travelled to San Francisco, where it was made into white sugar, and then to New York, where it was *packaged, before it came back to Maui. So the sugar that people ate in Maui had grown a few *kilometres away, but had travelled about 16,000 kilometres.

Because the world's population is growing, people are now thinking about how we will be able to make or grow enough food for everyone in the future.

For example, two billion people in the world already eat insects, but more people may start eating them, because they are easier to produce than *farm animals. They also give us a lot of energy, and are very healthy. Sea plants may become a more popular food in the future (A) the same reasons.

Scientists are looking at new ways of making food, too. They have found a way to grow meat from animal *cells — the smallest living parts of animals. Some people think that if we grow meat in this way in the future, we will not need to keep farm animals any more.

Some companies are also now making 'GM' (*genetically modified) foods. GM foods are made when scientists add DNA from other *species to food plants like fruits and vegetables, to change them. For example, they can make the plants bigger and stronger, and easier to grow. Some GM crops can grow well even in droughts — times when there is no rain (B) all — and other GM crops do not get diseases. Because (C) this, some people think that GM foods will be important in the future.

But many people are worried (D) changing food in this way. They think that growing GM crops may damage the environment, and they also think that eating GM foods may be bad for our health.
