

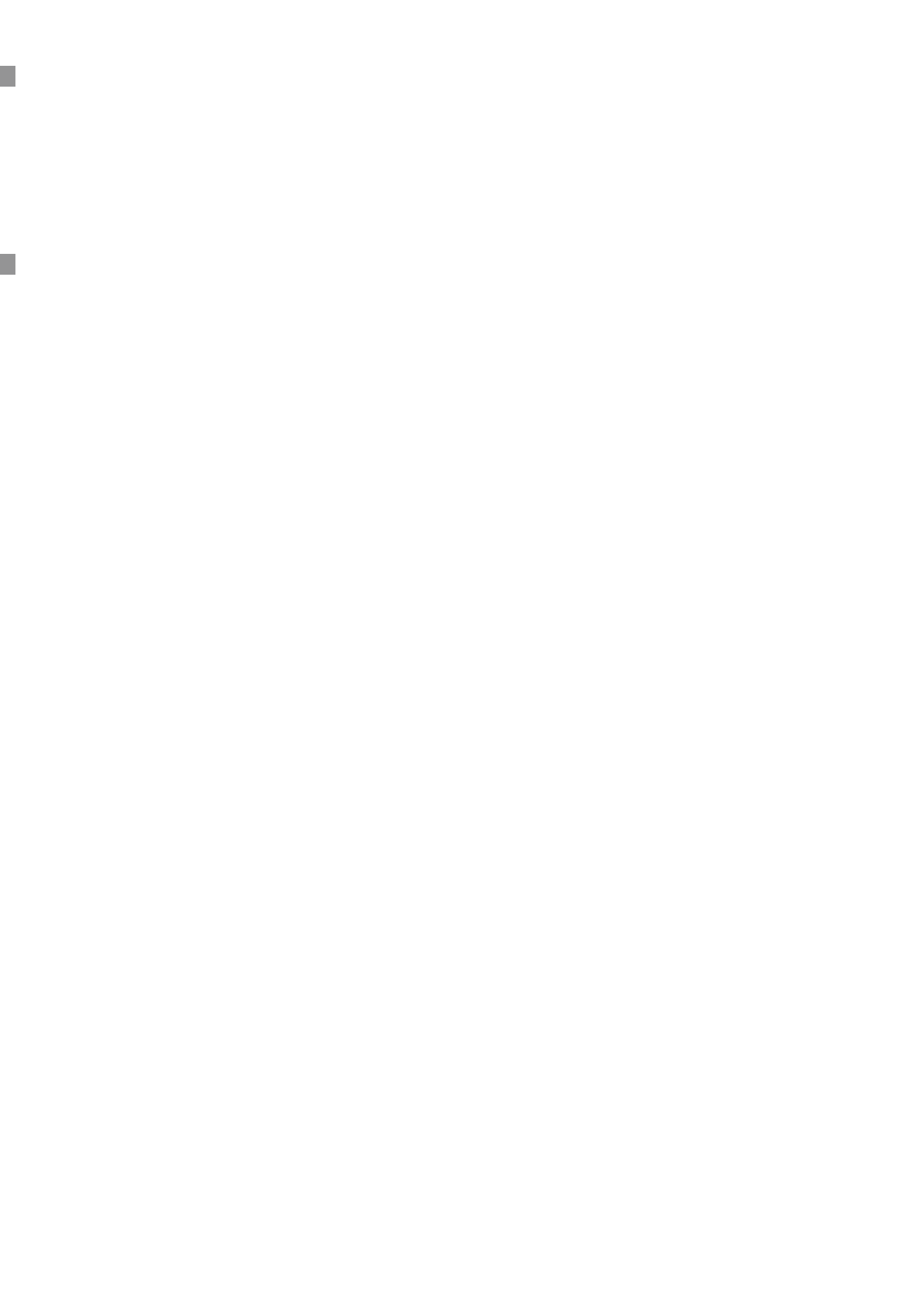

What do you like on your pizza? Cheese? Tomatoes? Pepperoni? People may disagree on their favorite *ingredients, but many people agree that pizza is a favorite food. Where and when did people start making pizza? To find out, we have to travel back in time. People were baking bread *dough on hot rocks in the Stone Age.

Stone Age people gathered ancient types of *wheat and other *grains. They mixed the grains into a *batter. Then they poured the batter onto rocks in their campfires. What they got was a flat bread—the first pizza *crust. *In time, *prehistoric bakers started using the flat bread as a plate. They put other food, herbs, and spices on the bread. Then they ate it.

Over the centuries, tastes changed. In the 1500s, European explorers tried to find a better way to sail to Asia to buy spices. Instead, they found a way to *the Americas. Native American people in Peru, Central America, and Mexico enjoyed eating tomatoes, but in Europe, people thought tomatoes were poisonous! *With time, Europeans and other people discovered that tomatoes were delicious and safe to eat. Cooks in Naples, an Italian city, began putting tomatoes onto baking dough.

People in Naples didn't stop there, however. They took another big step in pizza history. The world's first true pizza shop opened in Naples in 1830. Cooking pizza in Naples wasn't as easy as it is today. It was even a little dangerous. You see, pizza makers didn't use wood, gas, or electric ovens. Instead they used *lava from a nearby volcano to heat rocks for baking pizza dough. *Despite the danger, pizza was soon a big hit. People ate it for lunch and dinner. They even ate it for breakfast. News of the pizza shop spread quickly, and people traveled to Naples to try the tasty dish.

In the late 1800s, many Italians moved to the United States. They brought pizza with them. The first American pizzeria was Lombardi's in New York City. It opened its doors in 1905. Now pizza is one of the top three most popular U.S. foods. Of course, Americans are *hardly the only pizza lovers. Humans eat 5 billion pizzas a year. Our choices for toppings *vary widely. Brazilians love green peas on their pizza. Russians like

fish and onions. People in India use *lamb and tofu. The Japanese think eel and *squid are yummy. Some pizzas truly sound strange. Yet all share two things. Each begins with bread. And each is a slice of history.

Jim is scared. What does the black spot mean? Who is coming for Bones? What in the chest is so important?

Not wasting any time, Jim rushes over to Bones' old sea chest. Jim opens it, *fearful of what he might find inside. He picks up an old packet and is just about to open it when he hears the voices of strangers. Jim *tucks the packet away and runs out of the inn.

The three hold their breath as they open the packet. Inside, they discover a treasure map! The map *reveals that Captain Flint, a feared pirate, hid his treasure on a tropical island, and a black “X” marks the spot where it is buried.

“This map shows where Flint's treasure is!” Jim says. “Let's go get it!”

Jim and his two friends organize an *expedition to find the treasure. They *hire sailors for their crew, but Jim doesn't like the looks of one sailor, Long John Silver. He's a one-legged man who carries a parrot on his shoulder. He's always smiling, but Jim doesn't trust him. Jim has no idea that Silver and many of the other sailors were once members of Captain Flint's crew. They're pirates, and they're after Flint's treasure as well!

Fortunately for Jim, he does trust the ship's captain, Captain Smollett, who is tall, strong, and honest. As the ship sails off, Jim feels confident, but this confidence is ②shake after the ship's *first mate mysteriously dies. Then Jim *overhears Silver telling the pirate crew his *horrible plans.

“*Once we get to the island,” Silver *growls, “we’ll send Captain Smollett and that little troublemaker Jim to *Davy Jones’ locker!”

In a panic, Jim dashes off to tell Captain Smollett this news. “We’ll have to *be on our toes,” Smollett says, calming Jim down, and soon they come up (③) a plan.

When they reach the island, the pirates go ashore first. Captain Smollett and his men follow later, and they take over an old *fort. From this protected location, they are able to battle the pirates.

*Meanwhile, Jim has his own adventures on the island. He comes across Ben Gunn, who was *marooned on the island years earlier. When Jim returns to the fort though, rough hands *seize him. The pirates took over the fort while Jim was away, and Silver has *taken possession of the treasure map.

“This is for you!” says (i) pirate, handing Jim a black spot.

“That means death,” a ④ laugh Silver tells Jim.

“*Not so fast,” says (ii) pirate. “Here’s one for you, too.”

Silver *gulps as he looks at the black spot in his hand. “Jim,” he says quietly, “I know we’ve had our differences, but maybe we can help each other—and save both our lives!”

Jim has no choice *but to cooperate with Silver, who *convinces the pirates not to kill them. In exchange for their lives, Silver takes the pirates directly to where the treasure is buried. When they reach the location, though, their mouths drop open. ⑤ It has already been dug up!

BANG! BANG! The air is filled with the sound of gunfire. Dr. Livesey and Ben Gunn scare the pirates away, and rescue Jim. The men then lead Jim to a cave. There, in the light of a bright *bonfire, Jim sees the gold bars and coins guarded by Captain Smollett. The treasure of Captain Flint is theirs!
